CONTRIBUTION TO THE LICHEN FLORA OF ARGENTINA V. SOME NEW RECORDS

During the study of some recent lichens' collections from Argentina we could identify some species that had not yet been pointed out for this country.

We have also included in this paper some new localities for already known species which enlarge their distribution in Argentina.

The here mentioned collections are preserved in the Museo de Historia Natural de Montevideo (MVM) and in the private herbarium of the author. The specimens are fertile unless otherwise noted.

Anaptychia domingensis (ACH.) MASS. BUENOS AIRES: Punta Lara, on trunk of *Scutia buxifolia*, Osorio 5830 (herb. Osorio). Formerly known from the province of Misiones (OSORIO 1969).

Glyphis cicatricosa ACH. f. *confluens* (ZENK.) ZAHLBR. BUENOS AIRES: Punta Lara - Arroyo Boca Cerrada, on trunk of *Salix*, Osorio 5859, 5869 (herb. Osorio). New for the province.

Lobaria tenuis VAIN. MISIONES: Candelaria - Loreto, on trunk of *Leguminosae*, damp forest, not common, Montes, (herb. Osorio 3363, det. *I. Yoshimura*), on euphorbiaceous tree, damp forest, Montes, (herb. Osorio 3388), on sapindaceous tree, Montes, (herb. Osorio 3347); San Ignacio - Pastoreo Chico, on trunk of indigenous trees, dense forest, Montes, (herb. Osorio 5352, det. *I. Yoshimura*), San Ignacio - Gisela, on trunk of sapindaceous tree, ster., Montes, (herb. Osorio 3400). New to Argentina.

According with *I. Yoshimura* (in litt.) *Lobaria lobulifera* (MOORE 1969) is a synonym of *L. tenuis*.

Parmelia lindmanii LYNGE BUENOS AIRES: Punta Lara - Arroyo Boca Cerrada, on trunk of *Salix*, Osorio 5864, 5882, (herb. Osorio), on bark of branches, inside the forest, Osorio 5888, (herb. Osorio). Formerly known from the province of Misiones (OSORIO 1969).

Parmelia subcoronata MÜLL. ARG. MISIONES: San Ignacio - Pastoreo Grande, on branches of *Astronium Balansae* and *Helietta cuspidata*, open forest, Montes, (herb. Osorio 5388. A.). New to Argentina.

Strigula elegans (FÉE) MÜLL. ARG. Formerly known from Misiones, Salta, Tucumán and Jujuy (SANTESSON 1952). We add the following collections: MISIONES: San Antonio, Ragonese - Castiglioni, (MVM 17195); TUCUMAN: Burruyacú - Quebrada de las Pavitas - Sierra de la Ramada, 750 m.s.m., Peirano, (MVM 17194); CORRIENTES: Capital - Arroyo Riachuelo, Krapovickas, (MVM 17191); General Paz - Ibarrola, (MVM 17192), Paso Florentín, Ibarrola, (MVM 17193). All the above mentioned collections are growing on leaves of *Eugenia pungens*.

SUMMARY

Lobaria tenuis and *Parmelia subcoronata* are reported at first time for Argentina. For other four species new localities are pointed out.
